

Immediate Past District Governor

The immediate past district governor provides counsel and guidance to district officers and assists when requested by the district governor. He or she must have completed a term as district governor during the previous district year.

Responsibilities:

- Be a member of the executive committee and district council.
- Uphold the bylaws and policies of Toastmasters International and the district administrative bylaws, following them to the best of his or her ability.
- Serve as chairman of one or more district committees, such as the marketing committee.
- Provide guidance in district training programs or other areas of district operations.

Standards:

- Provide for a smooth transition at the beginning of the district year by turning over all pertinent district documents to the new district governor by June 30.
- Assist the audit committee in the timely completion of the year-end audit report, ensuring it is submitted to World Headquarters by August 31.
- Plan, direct and organize projects and programs as requested by the district governor or executive committee.
